Schumacher misjudged <b>the</b> cross <b>but</b> José Luis Brown didn't.</p> <p>11. Suddenly <b>the</b> West German defence, usually <b>so</b> efficient, <b>so</b> organised, simply seemed <b>to</b> crumble.</p> <p>12.
